Humphreys motion to approve consent agenda and minutes from the Feb. 18, 2015 AAB meeting. Dersahakian seconded the motion. Board unanimously approved the motion.

ITEM TWO: STAFF REPORT

English gave full staff report that included fuel sales, a budget report, equipment repairs, potential land sales, and potential equipment purchases for FY 2015/16. English said that current tenants, Metro Mart, are interested in purchasing the land they lease. Land would require an updated appraisal.

ITEM THREE: SUB COMMITTEE REPORTS

**ITEM FOUR: REPORT ON COST ESTIMATES FOR SPEC BUILDING AND HANGARS;
REPORT ON BUILDING AND HANGAR RATE SURVEY**

Tim Burg gave a report on the potential for the SEDF and the Shawnee Industrial Authority to build a shell building on airport property. He reported that the SIA is exploring other options and their interest in using the airport for a shell building is at this time is not moving any further. Burg commented that the Airport's goal of building T-hangars is a project worth pursuing while also seeking private partnerships.

ITEM FIVE: UPDATE ON CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR 2015

Kirk Evans of Lochner gave an update on the capital improvement for 2015/16. He showed the different options for apron lighting and beacon designs. Evans did report that both the apron lighting and beacon projects had been approved by the FAA, but the AWOS replacement is still pending the Cost Benefit Analysis although approval was very likely.

**ITEM SIX: DISCUSSION AND CONSIDERATION OF LEASING HANGAR 13 OFFICES
TO THE CIVIL AIR PATROL FOR RENOVATION AND USE**

English explained that the Civil Air Patrol is seeking office area to rent at a subprime rate. They are wanting to rent the north east hangar 13 offices which are in very poor condition, but will renovate them if given a heavily discounted rent rate. Sementelli, Erickson, and all the Board members agreed that the Civil Airport Patrol is and organization that justifiably could be given a "goodwill" lease but would need to charge a reasonable rate that is beneficial to both the CAP and airport. English also explained that negotiations are still ongoing. Humphreys motioned that

the airport eventually sign a lease with CAP that includes an initial term and renewal term that totals 10 years. Smallwood seconded the motion. Board unanimously voted to approve the motion.

ITEM SEVEN: DISCUSSION OF AIRPORT BUDGET FOR FY 2015/2016

English and Sementelli requested that this item be tabled until the April AAB meeting.

ITEM EIGHT: BOARD COMMENTS

Dersahakian recommended that we actively market commercial airport property that is available for use. Huddleston handed out airport maps that showed what portions of commercial airport property were unoccupied.

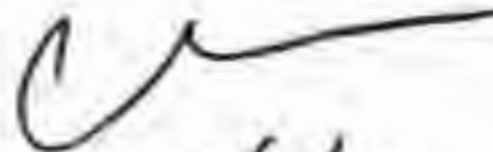

Nature of Situation: Airport staff is requesting the permission from the Shawnee Airport Authority to award a contract for FAA AIP Project No. 3-0040-08-16-2015 to LIBRA ELECTRIC COMPANY in Oklahoma City, OK.

Staff Analysis, Considerations: Libra Electric submitted the lowest bid at \$351,120. See attached bid tabulation for other bids.

The Airport budgeted \$348,505 for this project. Libra's bid is \$2,615 over budget, however, the Airport will be responsible for only \$216.50 for the cost after FAA reimbursement.

Contract period for construction is 45 calendar days from the commencement date specified in the Notice-to-Proceed. Liquidated damages are set at \$1,000 per calendar day. The award contract is contingent on grant funding.

Recommendation: Airport staff recommends awarding the project to LIBRA ELECTRIC. They are a very experienced company that has done much work on airport projects around the state. The Airport has used them in the past to install airfield lighting. The Airport's engineer, Lochner, Inc., also recommends awarding the Project to Libra (See attached recommendation letter).

Budget Consideration:
The cost of the project to the airport after a 90% FAA reimbursement will be \$35,112.

Dear Keenan:

We have completed tabulating and analyzing the bids for the above referenced project. As you are aware, two (2) bids were submitted and the apparent low bidder, Libra Electric was the apparent low. Based on the bids received and the interest shown by potential contractors we feel the project bidding phase was competitive. In addition, we feel that the proposed amount and respective unit prices submitted by Libra Electric represent a fair and reasonable price for the project.

We have successfully completed projects with Libra Electric as a prime and subcontractor that are similar to the proposed project at Shawnee Regional Airport. We have also reviewed the proposed DBE subcontractors and have verified that the proposed DBE contractors are approved DBEs to perform work in the State of Oklahoma. Therefore, we recommend the City of Shawnee enter into a contract **contingent on grant funding** with the apparent low bidder, Libra Electric, in the amount of \$351,120.00 for the work associated with the Base Bid plus Add Alternate II.

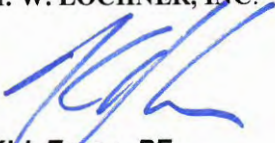
