1. LIMIT POPLAR STREET TO LOCAL TRAFFIC ONLY
2. CLOSE THE CENTER MEDIAN ON KICKAPOO AT POPLAR ST.

### REASONING

LARGE TRUCKS SHOULD USE OTHER AVAILABLE ACCESS TO THE DOMINO'S CONVENIENCE STORE. POPLAR STREET IS NOT INTENDED FOR COMMERCIAL TRAFFIC.

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With-in the request letter you will have noticed that Mr. Totty requested 2 items be placed on the agenda for consideration. I have chosen not to place his first request on the agenda so I wanted to give you all a brief explanation as to why. His first request was to limit Poplar Street to local traffic only to force the commercial trucks that come into the Domino site to use the other access points. While I can understand his concern, our city codes do allow commercial trucks the use of this street for the purpose of loading & unloading (Sec. 19-667b). Therefore I have decided to deny the request due to the fact that our existing city code already addresses the situation.
