VIII. ADJOURNMENT

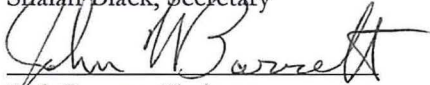
There being no further business to come before the Transportation Commission, a motion was made by Flood, seconded by Peltier recommending the meeting be adjourned. Motion **carried**
