Subject: Consideration of a Resolution authorizing the City Manager to accept a grant offer from the U.S. Department of Transportation Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) for the Reconstruct T-Hangar Taxilane project for the Shawnee Regional Airport.

Background: FAA provides grants to airports under the Airport Improvement Program (AIP) and the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act referred to as the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL). The Shawnee Regional Airport is eligible for a grant, under the BIL program, to support the reconstruction of a taxilane at the Shawnee Regional Airport. The BIL grant program provides for up to ninety-five percent (95%) of project costs and requires a local matching share of 5%.

Staff has provided the FAA with a project plan to confirm the proposed work will be eligible for the BIL grant program. Once the FAA accepts the project plan and scope of the work, staff will prepare a grant application.

In order to ensure the timely response to a grant offer securing the needed funds for this project, staff is seeking authorization for the City Manager to accept and execute any grant offers received from the FAA to secure funds for the project.

Following award of the grant, staff will then seek Shawnee Airport Authority, authorization to execute a task order with H.W. Lochner Engineering for the specific project-related design services.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT A GRANT OFFER FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION (FAA) FOR THE RECONSTRUCT T-HANGAR TAXILANE PROJECT FOR THE SHAWNEE REGIONAL AIRPORT.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Transportation Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) program offers assistance to airports through its Airport Improvement Program (AIP) and the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act referred to as the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL); and

WHEREAS, the FAA will provide BIL funds which represent ninety-five percent (95%) of the project cost; and

WHEREAS, the Shawnee Airport Authority will provide local funds which represent five percent (5%) of the project for the Shawnee Regional Airport; and

WHEREAS, the Shawnee Airport Authority has selected the firm H.W. Lochner, Inc., to provide consulting engineering services, in accordance with FAA procedures; and

WHEREAS, H.W. Lochner, Inc., will provide engineering planning services, in accordance with FAA rules and regulations; and

WHEREAS, the FAA requires the City Manager to be authorized to apply for and accept any grant funding offered; and

WHEREAS, the Shawnee Airport Authority has granted authority to the City Manager to sign and accept a Grant Offer from the FAA in support of the Reconstruct T-Hangar Taxilane Project at the Shawnee Regional Airport.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Shawnee Airport Authority, of the State of Oklahoma, Pottawatomie County, that the City Manager of the City of Shawnee is authorized to apply for and accept a Grant Offer from the Federal Aviation Administration for the Reconstruct T-Hangar Taxilane Project for the Shawnee Regional Airport.

Background: The Shawnee Airport Authority (SAA) benefits from grant opportunities offered by the Oklahoma Department of Aerospace and Aeronautics (ODAA) and the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA). When the SAA addresses large-scale development or rehabilitation projects, these two agencies often work in conjunction to provide essential financial support. To maximize the benefit of available state and federal grant resources, long-term development strategies for the Shawnee Regional Airport (SNL) should be developed in coordinated fashion across all three entities.

Under Oklahoma statute, the ODAA is empowered and directed to encourage, foster, and assist in the development of aerospace and aeronautics in Oklahoma and to encourage the establishment of airports and air navigation facilities. ODAA is further authorized to assist the federal government and airport authorities with the development of airport facilities and infrastructure and to facilitate agreement between the parties regarding project goals, and the allocation of financial resources.

The SAA has the opportunity to formalize this relationship through the approval of a resolution to authorize the ODAA to act as an agent on behalf of the SAA for the development of the Shawnee Regional Airport's Five-Year Capital Improvement Program (CIP).

If approved, the ODAA, will work with the SAA's airport staff and engineer of record to develop scopes, fees, and other CIP documentation. Prior to formal submission to the FAA, project descriptions, probable costs and sources of funding will be presented to the SAA for review and approval.

WHEREAS, the SAA and the ODAA desire to collaborate on the development of the CIP for the Shawnee Regional Airport; and

WHEREAS, the ODAA wishes to contribute its resources and expertise to the development of the CIP.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Shawnee Airport Authority that:

- A. The SAA hereby appoints the ODAA to act as the SAA's agent as authorized in 3 O.S. § 85 for the development of the Shawnee Regional Airport's CIP; and
- B. The ODAA, in its agent capacity, shall work with the SAA's airport staff and engineer of record to develop necessary scopes, fees, and other project related documentation for presentation to the SAA to support the infrastructure projects that are a part of the CIP; and
- C. ODAA shall present the CIP to the SAA for review and approval prior to submitting the CIP to the FAA.

Background: The City of Shawnee would like to engage Peter J. 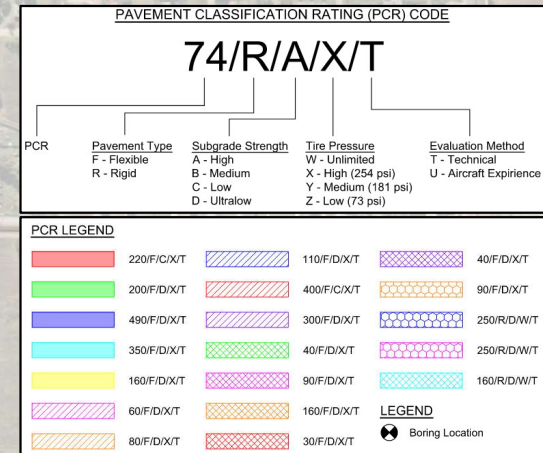

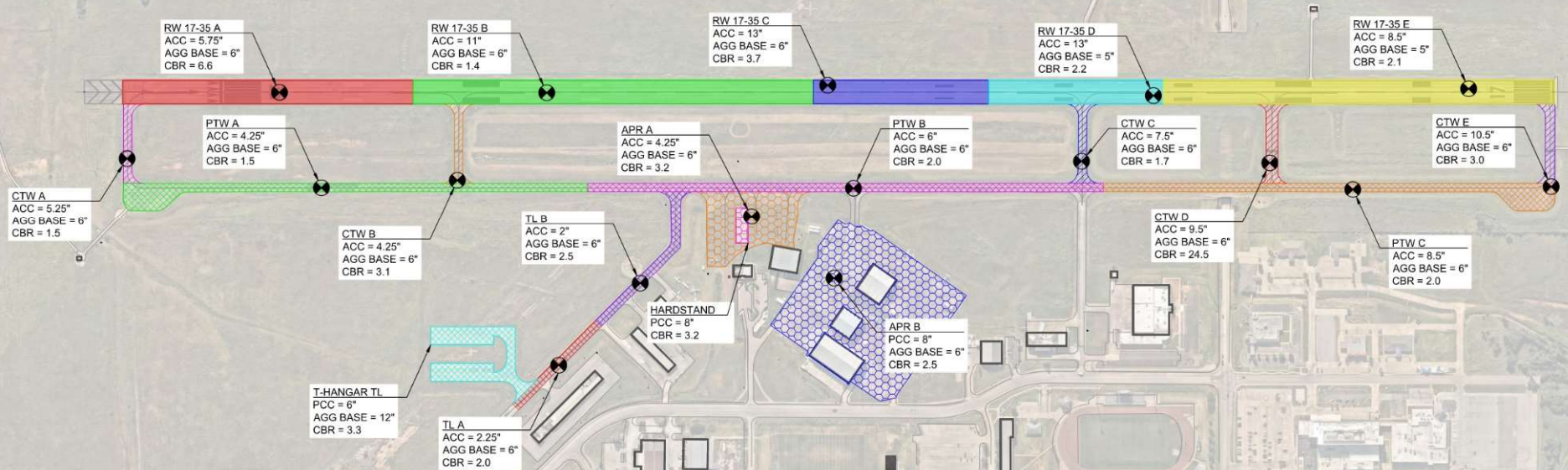
